

2006 Worker Incentive Points:

The Worker Incentive Points Program is being implemented to be more flexible than the current all or nothing program. The new Worker Incentive Program allows partial credit (it is no longer all or nothing wrt earning it), and more flexibility on how it may be applied.

Workers will earn a "Worker Point" for each full day credited as a volunteer, up to a maximum of 19 days. Worker Points will be credited for Oregon Region SCCA Regional and National weekends only, including the Rose Cup weekend. Sorry, but there will be no Worker Points credit for Pro events. The value of each Worker Point will be 3.75, however, any worker credited with the full 19 possible days will be rounded up to 80 points total.

Points will accumulate over the 2006 season to be applied against 2006 end of year use or 2007 use. Points earned during the 2006 season will vest at the conclusion of the season (ie no spending of points earned part way thru the season). In general points earned are non-transferable between workers, but exceptions can be made. Points will not carry over to 2008.

At the end of the 2006 season, Worker Points may be exchanged as payment towards any of the following three areas: The 2006 OR Region Annual Banquet, SCCA merchandise, or payment towards SCCA dues for 2007 via exchange with the Oregon Region Office. Worker Points may not be exchanged for beverage tickets (again sorry :-)

Specialty Chiefs are expected to take attendance and report to the SCCA Region Office at the conclusion of each event or at the end of the season. SCCA Regional Office will maintain the ongoing Worker Points tabulation. Points used for merchandise, Banquet or dues will be deducted from the Points tabulation. OR SCCA Merchandise and OR Banquet will coordinate with the Points Keeper for points utilized in those areas.

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
