Nasport is a semi-pro race organization run by the driver's group, and operated under the organization of the San Francisco Region of SCCA. Nasport operated for 16 straight years from 1987 thru 2003. The cars are generally GT3/GTL specification, purpose built tube frame race cars.

The series directors are announcing a 6-race series to be held over 3 double race weekends.

Laguna Seca (Mazda)	June 19-21st
Sears Point (Infineon)	Sept 4-6th

Drivers require only a regional level racing license and the standard SFR entry fee amount. The series is said to be organized to allow cars with some non-SCCA legal performance variations to compete using inexpensive methods of correction. All safety and race rules will be strictly SCCA compliant.
