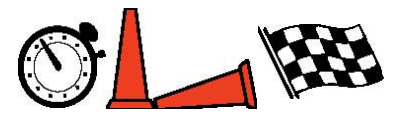




# Oregon Region SCCA Solo 2010 Points Event #4

	<b>REGISTRATION CLOSSES <u>PROMPTLY</u> AT PUBLISHED TIMES!</b>	
	Remove all loose items from vehicle and attach numbers to both sides. Immediately after Registration, take vehicle to tech/safety inspection area and have <u>completed</u> run card and helmet available for inspection. Tech will close fifteen minutes after Registration.	

Fees: \$25 Valid licensed drivers only.

All competitors must have an "Annual" or "Temporary Weekend" SCCA Membership to participate in each event.  
Temporary Weekend Membership - \$15.00 valid for 5 days (available at each event)

Annual Membership - \$80.00 / Individual Member (available at each event)  
Spouse, Family and Military Memberships are also available

\$15.00 credit from purchase of Temporary Weekend Membership can be applied towards purchasing an Annual Membership if Annual Membership is purchased within 60 days of purchasing Temporary Weekend Membership. Up to two \$15.00 credits may be applied when purchasing an Annual Membership.

Minors under 18 must have a "Minor Release and Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement" (Form MS-2) signed by parent or legal guardian.

Rule Books are available for purchase – though NOT required to compete at our events. You **MUST** have one to participate in the Annual Tech program, to lodge a protest or to compete at National level events. SCCA rules are available on line at <http://www.scca.com>.

You may reserve a permanent season number at Registration.

**Safety:** All vehicles must pass safety inspection on the following points prior to competing: seat belts, throttle return action, secure battery, no oil or antifreeze leaks, adequate brake pedal, tire condition, wheel bearings. All loose items, snap-on hubcaps, detachable fender skirts and trim rings must be removed. Real shoes are required (no sandals or flip-flops).  
**Helmets are required (Snell 95 or newer)** with some loaners available.

**Noise:** Oregon Region SCCA Solo will be monitoring sound in accordance with procedures published in the SCCA National Solo Rules. The limit at all Oregon Region SCCA Solo events is 100 decibels.

**Directions to Packwood Washington:** Take Interstate 5 or 205 North out of Portland toward Seattle to I-5 exit #68, Highway 12 East. Head east on highway 12 toward Morton and Yakima. It will be about 64 miles from interstate 5 to Packwood. The "Hampton Packwood Lumber Mill" will be one of the first things you come to in Packwood. It is on the right (south) side of highway 12.
