The Oregon Region SCCA Solo program is excited to host a novice school for the 2008 season. This school is offered to participants that are brand new to the sport of autocross or have competed in less than 10 events. This is an exciting chance for newcomers to get one-on-one, in-car instructions, from a veteran, Oregon Region, autocrosser. Participants will take runs both in the morning and the afternoon.

Organizers: The entire Oregon Region SCCA Solo committee

Qualifications: Entrants must have competed in LESS than 10 Oregon Region Solo autocrosses. Those who have never autocrossed are welcome also.

Cost (per student): \$40 for current SCCA members.

\$55 for non-SCCA members.

*** Includes \$15 for the required Temporary Weekend Membership. ***

For 2008, SCCA requires that all participants be SCCA members. The Temporary Weekend Membership is used and the cost is credited to you if you sign up for SCCA's annual membership.

PRE-REGISTRATION ONLY, REGISTRATION MUST BE MAILED AND POSTMARKED BY SAT, JUNE 21st. DON'T DELAY SENDING IN YOUR ENTRY. THE SCHOOL WILL LIKELY BE FULL BEFORE THE DEADLINE.

Number of entrants: Only 30 spots are available. First come, first serve. It will fill up fast.

9:00 AM	SHARP!!! Morning runs begin.
12:00 – 12:45 PM	(Approximate time) Lunch break. Bring your lunch with you!
12:45PM	SHARP!!! Afternoon runs begin.
3:30 PM	School ends.

Things to bring with you to the school:

Drivers license

Brown-bag lunch, pop, juice (BOTTLED WATER WILL BE SUPPLIED)

Full tank of fuel

A minimum of 3/32 – 4/32 of tread depth on your tires

Street tires should be inflated to their maximum PSI, found on the sidewall of the tire.

Oregon Region SCCA Solo 2008 Novice School #2 Registration Form

IMPORTANT!!! Please read each line very carefully:

- This is an all day school, rain or shine. If you cannot dedicate the whole day please do not register.
 - This school is limited to people who have never participated in an autocross or who have participated in less than 10 Oregon Region SCCA Solo events.
 - Only 30 entrants will be accepted, first come, first serve basis. It will fill up fast so do not wait to register.
 - **Pre-registration is required. Entry forms must be mailed and postmarked by Saturday June 21, 2008** .
 - Refunds will ONLY be given if a cancellation is submitted BEFORE 7 days prior to the school. No exceptions.
 - Participants must comply with Section 4.1.A of the SCCA Solo Rulebook and present a VALID DRIVERS LICENSE at the time of check-in. If you fail to comply, you WILL NOT be allowed to participate and NO REFUND will be given.
 - Participants must comply with Section 4.3 of the SCCA Solo Rulebook, which defines the safety gear a driver needs to participate in a Solo event. This includes helmets, footwear, seatbelts, etc. Loaner helmets will be available.
 - All cars must pass a technical inspection on the day of the school. Cars must meet all of the criteria defined in Section 3.3 of the SCCA Solo Rulebook. Refund WILL NOT be given to cars that fail the technical inspection.
 - All cars must have TWO seats with seatbelts.
 - **Participants MUST be willing to let the instructors drive their car, as this is a very important part of the learning process.**
 - If a person under the age of 18 intends to attend this school, they need to contact either Michael via email or phone, prior to registering. In this situation, there are special considerations that need to be addressed.
 - All participants must work their assigned shifts in order to participate. If it is found that someone has not worked their assigned shift, they will be asked to leave immediately and will not be given a refund.
 - Please bring a lunch with you. The lunch break will be fairly short to maximize the amount of runs you will get.
 - Participants are financially responsible for any damages they cause to the facility or Solo equipment.
