Who is it for?

- For seasoned track day enthusiast in a street legal car or race prepared car.
- Competition license is not required.
- Previous experience accepted: high performance driving schools, club track days, Track Night in America, competition license holders.

How much does it cost?

- \$150 for three (20 minute) sessions
- Rental of transponder for timing \$20 per day (optional)

- Three (20 minute) sessions held on Saturday and/or Sunday of the 2018 SCCA Road Racing event weekends at Portland International Raceway

 - Sunday, August 12
